

# Corporate Treasury Resilience in the Middle East

## 2026 MENA Flash Study

July 28, 2026

**Executive Summary:** This report provides detailed information from corporates in the Middle East covering topics such as overall business outlook, top strategic priorities, business performance, and more given the ongoing crisis. **Methodology:**

In June 2026, Crisil Coalition Greenwich interviewed 85 respondents across the Middle East, including the UAE, Saudi Arabia, Egypt, Oman, Bahrain, Kuwait, and Qatar. Participants were senior corporate finance decision-makers such as CFOs, Finance Directors, Treasurers, and Financial Controllers from companies with annual revenues typically of USD 250 million or more.

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
